# Eucaland

The **Institute for Research on European Agricultural Landscapes** e.V. (EUCALAND) is an expert network that analyzes agricultural landscapes of Europe in order to

- raise awareness and promote their sustainable use,
- preserve their cultural heritage,
- cooperate with international institutions.



The idea of the network was born at a working meeting at the UNESCO World Heritage Centre in 2005 when it became clear that the so-called ordinary farming landscapes are much too often neglected and suffer from a lack of knowledge.

## Mission and Goals

- Increase the valorisation and accessibility of European Agricultural Landscapes (EAL), with their visible and invisible character, and their tangible and intangible values, for all people.
- Contribute to a better understanding, sustainable use, and preservation of the landscapes' identity and heritage.
- Provide advice to governments and authorities on all levels in establishing classifications, planning and policy development.
- Provide methods and toolkits for the description, classification and assessment of landscapes to stakeholders and scientists, such as UNESCO, CoE, PECSRL, IUCN, WWF, FAO, NGOs, Landscape Planners, Politicians, and the European Public.

- We coordinate and manage project initiatives and support networking of members
